Any other specific items.	<p>PROTOCOL FOR STORAGE OF FUEL AND OTHER HAZARDOUS FLUIDS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> During Event days, only a working stock of fuel for one day may be present in the garage, awning or trailer. All other stock should remain in the fuel compound. The fuel should be stored in sealed containers, drums or cans. The working stock may not be located in the route of forklift trucks or other means of transport. The working stock may not exceed 400 liters and must be placed on a drip tray with a capacity of +10%. Two fire extinguishers with a minimum capacity of 6 liters and suitable for class B fires (liquid) must be present in direct surrounding of the storage. Presence of sufficient absorbents which can be used in case of spillage. <p>Each team is responsible for the drip trays, extinguishers, grit and absorbents. A daily check will take place to ensure that each team meets all requirements.</p>
