These Supplementary Regulations shall be based on the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) and Appendices, the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, the Anti-Doping-Regulations of the international Anti-Doping Agency (WADA Code) and the Anti-Doping Regulations of the FIA, the Sporting and Technical Regulations of the series and the KNAF approved modifications and supplements (Bulletins), the Supplementary Event Regulations including modifications and supplements (Bulletins), the FIA Code of Good Conduct, as well as the other provisions issued by the FIA.

For this series, the regulations (sporting and technical regulations) of the respective series also apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to said Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins.

According Art. 13 & 15 of the FIA Sporting Code International protests have to be addressed and delivered to the Chairman of the Stewards. In absence of the Chairman of the Stewards, the protest should be delivered to one of the other stewards, or in their absence, to the race director or assistant.

Fuel: see Series Technical Regulations Noise regulations: see Series Technical Regulations

Pitlane Speed: Maximum 60Km/h

Qualifying minima: 107% of the best qualifying time in the respective class

Race classification: Minimum 75% of the winner's laps, chequered flag not needed

Protocol for storage of fuel and other hazardous fluids for all championships

- During event days, only a working stock of fuel for one day may be present in the garage, awning or trailer. All other stocks should remain in the fuel compound.
- The fuel should be stored in sealed containers, drums or cans.
- The working stock may not be located in the route of forklift trucks or other means of transport.
- The working stock may not exceed 400 liters and must be placed on a drip tray with a capacity of +10%.
- Two fire extinguishers with a minimum capacity of 6 liters and suitable for class B fires (liquid) must be present in direct surrounding of the storage.
- Presence of sufficient absorbents which can be used in case of spillage.

Each team is responsible for the drip trays, extinguishers, grit and absorbents.

A daily check will take place to ensure that each team meets all requirements.
