

# Supplementary Regulations Round 6 – Trophy of the Dunes Circuit Zandvoort 26 – 28 September 2025

#### Introduction

The Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux 2025 is organised in conformity with the provisions of the International Sporting Code and its appendices (the Code), and the National Sporting Regulations of the KNAF. It will be run in conformity with the Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux 2025 Sporting and Technical Regulations, the FIA Appendix J (Art. 277) and the Code of driving conduct.

The Series will be run according to the above regulations. For the avoidance of doubt, should there be any inconsistency or conflict between the individual sets of regulations, then the order of priority shall be firstly those of the International Sporting Code, then the Porsche Carrera Cup Benelux Regulations, followed by the KNAF Regulations and thereafter these Supplementary Regulations.


#### 1.9 SPECIAL EVENT RELATED ITEMS

Any other event related

1. In addition to Appendix H of the 2025 FIA International Sporting Code and the KNAF Reglementen Boek 2025 it is possible that at post 0.5 and



- 1, post 7 and 7.4, post 8 and 8.2, post 10.7 and 11 and post 14 and 14.3 the same flags will be shown as a pre-warning (yellow flags).
- 2. All pit garages must be kept locked from the inside to avoid unauthorised persons passing through to pit lane, fines maybe imposed by the Stewards on offenders.
- 3. Refuelling is only allowed in the pit lane or on the paddock.
- 4. All fuel must be stored in drip trays.
- 5. During event days, only a working stock of fuel for one day may be present in the garage, awning or trailer. All other stock should remain in the fuel compound.
- 6. The fuel should be stored in sealed containers, drums or cans.
- 7. The working stock may not be located in the route of forklift trucks or other means of transport.
- 8. The working stock may not exceed 400 liters and must be placed on a drip tray with a capacity of +10%.
- 9. Two fire extinguishers with a minimum capacity of 6 liters and suitable for class B fires (liquid) must be present in direct surrounding of the storage.
- 10. Presence of sufficient absorbents which can be used in case of spillage.
- 11. Each team is responsible for the drip trays, extinguishers, grit and absorbents.
- 12. A daily check will take place to ensure that each team meets all requirements.
- 13.
- 14. Access to the pit: minimum age is 16 years (except holders of a racing Licence).
- 15. It is not allowed to smoke or use open fire in the pit boxes, in the pit lane and on the roof of the pitlane building.
- 16. The pit lane has been divided into two lanes. The lane closest to the pit wall/track is designated the 'fast lane' and the lane closest to the pit boxes is designated the 'inner lane' or 'working lane' and is the only area where any work can be carried out on a car. Exceptions can be made by the Race Director at a red flag situation.
- 17. Competitors may not paint lines on any part of the pit lane.
- 18. No equipment may be left in the fast lane of the pit lane. A car may enter or remain in the fast lane only with the driver sitting in the car behind the steering wheel in his normal position, even when the car is being pushed.
- 19. Team personnel are only allowed in the pit lane immediately before they are required to work on a car and must withdraw as soon as the work is complete.
- 20. The driver must sign the 'responsibility clause' (according to the General regulations concerning racing contests).
- 21. For minor competitors a "Parental Consent Authorisation" should be presented at Administrative Control, in case the parent will not be present at the meeting.
- 22. For entrants, other than the driver concerned, not present at this meeting a written authorisation should be presented at Administrative Control.





- 23. Every person (drivers, team members, officials, press etc.) who enters the pit area must at all times wear his ticket/pass visible, in a way that the controlling officials can at any time without problem see whether this person has the right ticket/pass. If a person is not wearing his ticket/pass visible, he may not enter the pit area.
- 24. Every car shall be timed at the start/finish line after completion of the first and subsequent laps with a transponder. All cars have to be equipped with a permanent transponder, which must be mounted in the car at the right place. Malversation or obstruction of the rules mentioned in this article may lead to exclusion and shall be reported to the Stewards.
- 25. Every competitor, team owner, driver team-member who wishes to use an apparatus with radio communication must submit an application at least 1 month before the event the application form can be obtained on the internet at:

- 26. Tobacco advertisements is totally banned by Dutch law and must therefore be neutralized, even if they are part of the car's original decoration.
