2.2. Briefings:

Given the special situation, it is not possible to organize a physical drivers briefing, so it has been decided to hand over the drivers briefing notes on paper to the drivers and spotters for this race day.

2.3.3 Races

All competitors must be ready to take their car to the track 15 minutes prior to the start of the race. Competitors arriving after this time may be ordered to start from the back of the grid.

And also 15 minutes before the indicated start time per session, the spotter must switch on the radio receiver and listen to any announcements from the race director. Our advice to the spotter is to go directly to the spotter's location at this time, because if the spotter is not present at the spotter's location, the car will not be allowed to enter the circuit.

2.4 Pit & Paddock

Read the information below carefully and adhere to the rules

Measures related to Covid-19

- Everyone keeps a distance of 1.5 meters from each other
- If you have complaints such as coughing, sore throat or fever, stay at home!
- The temperature of every visitor / driver is measured before entry. When elevated, you are not allowed on the site.
- Desinfection material is available at various places on the circuit. Make use of this.
- Everyone should sit down as much as possible. Every entrance band gives free access to the stands! Pass this on to your guests.
- Registration by driver is already done in advance (before July 24). At gate 1 you can pay and collect the registration fee and the ordered entrance tickets. So not in the Welcome Center! Each driver may order a maximum of 10 entrance tickets. Because it is not yet clear whether tickets can still be sold at the box office.
- It is not possible to pay with a card on the circuit! Keep this in mind.

- Wearing a mouth mask is mandatory in the stands during transfers! It is also recommended to wear a face mask on the circuit outside the stands, but this is not mandatory. Mouth masks are available at the entrance. Costs of the mask below are € 5. You can of course also provide your own mouth mask.
- Mechanics and driver receive a different Entrance band! Mechanics are required to wear face masks while tinkering / performing work on the car. Each driver receives 2 tickets for the mechanics.
- You have been able to order extra tickets for your guests. Request your guests to contact you (or someone on your team) to deliver the tickets to them at the entrance gate.
- Your guests have access to the stands with their entrance ticket. Due to the corona measures, they should take place in the stands as much as possible and do not stand along the track!
- Due to the high costs and the limitation on the number of visitors, there is unfortunately no prize money to be distributed. Also, no travel costs are provided. For the first 3 drivers of the day classification of each class there is of course a cup and beautiful bunch of flowers.
- No flowers are awarded to the drivers after each race, nor is there any lap of honor.
- After the final races, the cups and flowers will be awarded to the first 3 of the day classification immediately on the track. The first 3 drivers take place on the podium car that is already ready in front of the main grandstand on the long track!
- It concerns a day classification, the points do not count for anything else! V8 Oval Series driving for Dutch championship.
- Transponders can be rented from the competition management (Bart Loonen), not in the Welcome Center.
- Catering; van Heijst is present in various places with drinks and food. The canteen and VIP area will remain closed!
- There is no camping!
- PITBOXES; the following rules apply to those who rent a pit box. The pit boxes may only be manned by the driver and his / her 2 mechanics and possibly a spotter. Furthermore, there may NOT be an audience, sponsors and / or guests in the pit boxes. Catering is also not allowed in the pit boxes.
- In the pit boxes everyone wears the mouth masks.
- If you do NOT comply with the rules, you must leave the site immediately and you may no longer participate in the competitions.

4.15 Tyres

4.15.3 Hoosier is the official tyre supplier for the V8 Oval Series.

During the season the use of slick tyres (Hoosier/Amarican Races) is maximized by 12 tyres at the first 4 race days. At the races of 26/27-12-2020 it is aloud to use 4 extra tyres. Each tyre will have its serial number registered with the V8 Oval Series. Drivers have to sign in the tyres with serial numbers of all tyres they've used before the first race. (From 2021 we only race with Hoosier tyres)
